School News	 Pentecost Service – a wonderful morning at Chichester Cathedral on Wednesday with the children performing 3 hymns in total. The service was led by Canon Dr Anthony Cane. Staff vs Children week was a huge success: with the teachers winning netball and football and the children winning cricket and athletics, baseball was a draw. We were very proud of the children's sportsmanship and the support of the children who were watching. Next week, we are launching a Celebration Assembly at 2.45pm every Friday afternoon, this is an opportunity to celebrate the children's successes both in and out of school: so if your child has achieved a medal or certificate for an activity at home, please allow them to bring it in so we can all join together in celebrating their achievements.
Circle Meetings	 As a result of our circle meetings and taking into account our children's views, we are also launching a number of new and exciting reward systems, these include: Secret Student - each morning a child will secretly be chosen at random and monitored throughout the day, if this child shows positive behaviour during a session they will achieve a tick. If they can get four out of the five possible ticks, they will receive a certificate at the end of the day and be celebrated in class. If, by Friday, the Secret Students have earned twenty out of a possible twenty-five ticks they will earn a Secret Student Celebration for the whole class on a Friday afternoon. Star Pupil - each week teachers will choose two children per class who have completed good examples of learning, they will receive a certificate in our Celebration Assembly and their work shared with the school. Diddy-Dots - if a child has demonstrated good behaviour all week, on a Friday afternoon, they will receive a diddy-dot for their card, if by the end of a half term they can achieve a diddy-dot every week, they will get to choose a reward at the end of the half term.
